## Did you know FREE mental health & substance use treatment is available for St. Charles County children & families?



Since 2004, CCRB has managed the St. Charles County Children's Community Services Fund, funded by a 1/8 cent sales tax.

Funds are used to ensure mental health and substance use treatment services are available for all St. Charles County youth, up to 19 years of age. Children (and their families) are eligible to receive services regardless of family income or insurance status.
