The CCRB partners with non-profit agencies to provide mental health and substance use treatment services to improve the quality of life for children, youth, and families in St. Charles County.

For every dollar spent in St. Charles County, 1/8 of a cent is dedicated to services for St. Charles County children and teens, up to 19 years of age. The CCRB oversees the administration, allocation, and distribution of funds from this local sales tax.

Efficient funding and high-quality services contributes to St. Charles County consistently ranking #1 for overall child well-being in Missouri by Missouri Kids Count.
